<i>Achnatherum hymenoides</i>	Indian Ricegrass	bunch grass
<i>Asclepias speciosa</i>	Showy Milkweed	rhizomatous/Monarch host plant
<i>Bouteloua gracilis</i>	Blue Grama grass	rhizomatous
<i>Campanula rotundifolia</i>	Harebells	long bloom time
<i>Coreopsis lanceolata</i>	Tickseed	
<i>Echinacea angustifolia</i>	Narrow-leafed Coneflower	
<i>Ericameria nauseosa</i>	Rabbitbrush	one of the last blooming plants of the season
<i>Festuca idahoensis</i>	Blue Idaho Fescue Grass	bunch grass
<i>Gaillardia aristata</i>	Blanketflower	
<i>Geranium viscosissimum</i>	Sticky Geranium	
<i>Helianthus maximiliani</i>	Maximilian's Sunflower	
<i>Heterotheca villosa</i>	Hairy False Goldenaster	
<i>Liatris ligulistylis</i>	Rocky Mountain Gayfeather

<i>Monarda fistulosa</i>	Bee Balm (Horse Mint)	rhizomatous
<i>Penstemon eatonii</i>	Eaton's (Firecracker) Penstemon	
<i>Penstemon grandiflorus</i>	Large-flowered Beardtongue	
<i>Penstemon palmerii</i>	Palmer's Penstemon	fragrant flowers
<i>Penstemon strictus</i>	Rocky Mountain Penstemon	
<i>Prunus pumila</i>	Western Sandcherry	fragrant flowers/red leaf color in fall
<i>Ratibida columnifera</i>	Prairie Coneflower	short lived perennial/self seeds readily
<i>Ribes aureum</i>	Golden Current	fragrant flowers/yellow leaf color in fall
<i>Rudbeckia hirta</i>	Black-eyed Susan	biennial or short lived perennial/self seeds readily
<i>Schizachyrium scoparium</i>	Little Bluestem	bunch grass/rust color in winter
<i>Solidago rigida</i>	Stiff Goldenrod	
<i>Symphyotrichum novae-angliae</i>	New England Aster	
<i>Symphyotrichum oblongifolium</i>	Aromatic Aster	
<i>Tradescantia occidentalis</i>	Prairie Spiderwort
